A. Draft of the budget was reviewed. Highlights of the discussion:

- Capital reserve fund is not included in the draft. We are allowed to include up to 15% of the budget.
- Currently the flat rate for users is \$74.18 which has not changed since the beginning. Troy and Jay now pay the same since the bonds have been paid off.
- Jay Peaks current flow charge has seen an increase and is currently 1.5 cents per gallon while regular user fees have not seen increases.
- Dave will meet with Steve to review the income and rate charges to determine what needs to be charged to balance the budget.

B. They are currently working inside replacing the UV lights with the ones we got from Castleton. The next maintenance project will be changing the filters.

C. In reference to a question by Gaston, Steve said there is not usually a problem with hydrants freezing from being buried in the snow.
