BOARD OF SELECTPERSONS MINUTES

The Board of Selectpersons held their monthly meeting on Monday, March 16, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. at the Troy Municipal Office.

1. The Meeting opened at 6:32 PM
2. Steve reported that the VTrans permit for the Pleasant Street water line project has been submitted. Steve has not heard anything yet regarding the grant we received through Becca Balant.
3. Mike reported the roads are in great condition. There was very little damage from mud season so far. He brought two quotes for a new 2027 truck. The board reviewed both quotes, one from Allegiance and one from Charlesbois, A motion was made by Gaston to purchase a Western Star truck from Charlesbois in the amount of \$315,200, which includes the warranty, to be ordered in the fall of 2026. A motion was made by Gaston to sign the lease for the 2026 International truck for a 7-year term.
