BOARD OF SELECTPERSONS MINUTES

The Board of Selectpersons held their monthly meeting on Tuesday, June 16, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. at the Troy Municipal Office.

1. The Meeting opened at 6:30 PM
2.
 - (a) Steve received an email from EPA regarding the Pleasant Street Project grant. There are various documents that need to be completed. Mike Mainer, our engineer from Aldrich & Elliott, will be completing some of them. Steve and Terri will complete the rest. There is also a webinar tomorrow that Steve and Terri have signed up for.
 - (b) Steve explained phase 1 & 2 of the project is ready to go out to bid. Phase 3 requires an environmental review. He recommended we begin phase 1&2 while waiting for the review to be completed for phase 3.
 - (c) There is a rate-setting training on October 13th in Morrisville that Steve will attend.

 - (a) Mike reported that the town received a Grants In Aid grant in the amount of \$14,000. Terri and Mike had a zoom meeting with Elise Grant from the state highway department to review the segments of road that will be ditched.
 - (b) Mike Montgomery has started roadside mowing.
 - (c) With the hard rain we have been getting, we have been lucky and have had just a few washouts.
4. Gary Taylor spoke with the board regarding River Road. Ben Marriner is interested in continuing the paving on River Road to his driveway. He will pay for the paving, with no expense to the town. If done, Ben would not hold any liability for the road, as it is owned by

the town. Terri will contact VLCT tomorrow and pending approval, a motion was made by Robert to approve Mr. Marriner paving River Road from where the tar currently ends, to his driveway.

5. In public comments: Brian Kirsch addressed Anne and Robert regarding his zoning application.
6. Jordan Flynn, from Troy School, spoke to the board regarding a color run event on September 26th in Troy or North Troy to benefit the playground project.
7. Ellen Fox and Sarah Myrenton spoke with the board regarding the idea of forming a recreation committee. Ellen is going to get a list of towns that currently have a committee and give them to Terri to investigate.
8. The Plan of Merger was reviewed with changes made.
9. Minutes of May 19, 2026, were approved by a motion made by Anne.
10. All warrants were signed.
11. 2 Overweight permits were signed by Robert.
