BOARD OF SELECTPERSONS MINUTES

The Board of Selectpersons held their monthly meeting on Tuesday, August 18, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. at the Troy Municipal Office.

1. The Meeting opened at 6:33 PM
2. Gaston requested we add the sale of the ballfield from Troy school to the Town of Troy and add the school/town lighted sign to the agenda
3. Steve reported that the Pleasant Street water line project was going to be set up in grants.gov tomorrow. He indicated that in September the project should be going out to bid for Spring, 2027 construction.
4. Mike reported that the Viking body was being installed on the new truck. We should have the new truck at some point this fall.
5. Gaston let the board know all information has been sent to Memphremagog Press for the Merger vote. The board reviewed the slide deck for the informational meetings.
6. Gaston made the motion to authorize pre-buying 2600 gallons of fuel oil from Oil Supply at \$3.88 gallon for a total of \$10,088.00.
7. Gaston spoke to the board about inviting members of the Troy PTA and/or Troy school to the next regular board meeting to discuss the lighted sign at the entrance of the driveway.
8. The transfer of the Troy School ball ground property was discussed. Gaston suggested leaving the deed description as it is currently written with the same conditions. Robert recommended Gaston contact the Troy school attorney to prepare the documents for the transfer.

9. Minutes of July 14, 21, and 28, 2026, were approved by a motion made by Gaston
